In February of 2018, Nu Star Maker Performing Arts & Talent Management Inc., contracts with the City of Powder Springs, GA to bring visibility and community utilization to their 7,000 square foot Cultural Arts Center located on the George Ford Campus in downtown Powder Springs. Now, the center, fondly known as “The CAC,” has a renewed planned purpose and identity as a Community Performing Arts and Cultural Arts facility thanks to the organizing and planning efforts of Carnita Jones and her full/part-time staff members Arianna Shropshire, Matthew Shropshire, and Victoria Hampton.
